"We must be all alive." Thomas Merton's call to us seems a little easier on this glorious Easter morning, when we celebrate the miracle of the Resurrection. Just as Christ conquered death and darkness, we realize that life in the Spirit is always about renewal, restoration, healing and wholeness.

Pope Francis reminded us what Easter is about in his Easter Vigil homily from last year:

"Let us celebrate Easter with Christ! He is alive! Today, too, he walks in our midst, changes us and sets us free. Thanks to him, evil has been robbed of its power; failure can no longer hold us back from starting anew; and death has become a passage to the stirrings of new life. RESEARCH STUDY ON THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

My name is Ella Engquist, and I am a Junior studying sociology here at Michigan. I am conducting a pilot study for SOC 310 (Sociological Research Methods) that also serves as preliminary research for my senior honors thesis about the importance of Catholic confession.

As a lifelong Catholic myself, I am curious about others' encounters with confession, and want to understand them from an embodied perspective. Within the next 2-3 weeks, I am hoping to speak with 8 to 10 Catholic students interested in discussing their perspectives on and experiences with reconciliation. These interviews last 30-45 minutes (though more extensive timeframes are more than welcome!) and are semi-structured. Our conversation will simply be a space to talk about confession freely, and explore your experiences with the sacrament in whatever way you see fit! All data will be kept anonymous and confidential.

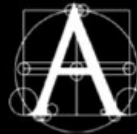
