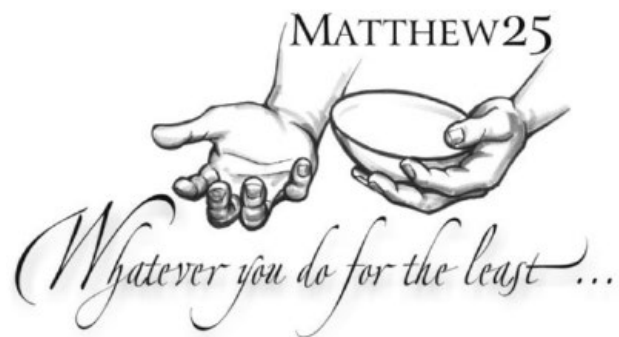

As an apostolic parish, we are committed to ongoing formation of Christian witness, discipleship, and leadership.

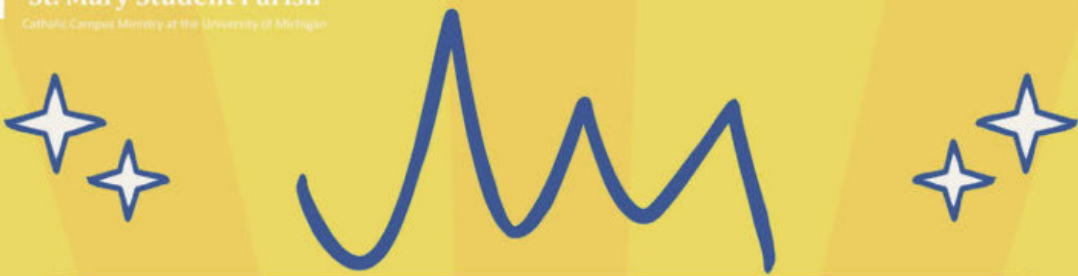

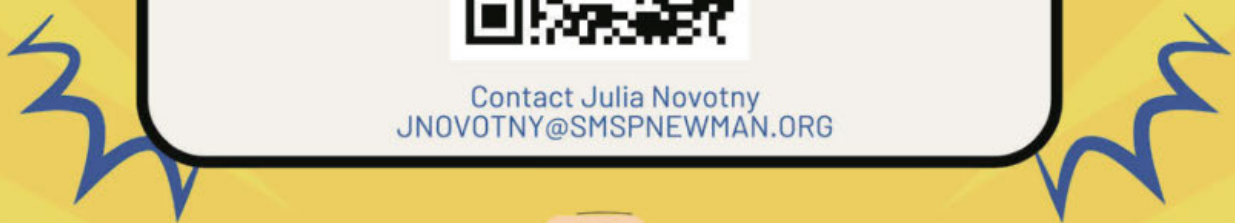
